

Funds Use Plan – Bement CUSD 5

The funding will be used in various ways:

- \$12,500 will be used for sanitation and deep-cleaning devices and supplies to keep the school safe. This includes Clorox electrostatic sprayers, deep cleaning cloths, fans, hepa-filters, mops, gloves, air filtration for classrooms, and sanitation safe spray chemicals.
- \$10,000 for salary for counseling for the social-emotional needs of students and staff with the Piatt County Mental Health Department.
- \$250 for clothing and/or supplies for homeless student needs when they arise.
- \$125,000 for funding toward a new boiler system to circulate the air more efficiently and \$137,000 to replace and upgrade windows in the high school so that they can be safely opened and closed to improve ventilation.
- \$47,899 will be spent on salaries for our after school program coordinators and tutors to address Loss of Learning.
- \$5,000 will be spent on the benefits for the salaries for the Loss of Learning tutors/plan.
- \$2,500 will be spent on possible “hotspots” for families in cases where they have internet needs in case of remote learning.
- \$36,735 will be spent on supplies, purchase of curriculum and Chromebooks for students who have experienced learning loss and are in our programs to provide assistance. We will be sure that the interventions will address social, emotional, mental health, and the academic needs of all students, particularly those students impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
